CSK's innovative solution



New beneficiaries bring new opportunity for positive impact.

The planet cannot carry more waste and CSK beneficiaries cannot afford to buy diapers and feminine hygiene products. There are innovative solutions and CSK is investing in them.

CSK is saving thousands of dollars and significantly reducing our impact on landfills by investing in reusable/biodegradable diapers from Gelwear, an Ecuadorian company.

Hygiene kits cost \$30, last 5 years, and contain reusable pads, panties, and a carry bag. Kits save \$240 per woman every five years and keep 1,450 pads out of landfills. Access to hygiene kits keeps girls at school and women at work according to the World Health Organization. Our kits are distributed in reproductive health and contraception workshops led by Dr. Maité Depreeuw.

Diaper kits cost \$100, last two to three years, contain 2 shells and 12 pads, save \$2,500 per child, and keep 7,000 diapers per child out of landfills! Gelwear diapers biodegrade 100 times faster than disposable diapers.

Long-lasting eco-friendly diapers and hygiene products produced in Ecuador, provide a win, win, win by investing in the future of our planet, the health of our neighbors, as well as the local economy.
