Three years ago, Antonio Araujo and his family founded PRIMOK, the first English school in the province of Cañar. Currently, they have more than 140 students ages 5 to 17 and have hosted over 35 foreign volunteer teachers.

Antonio and his family firmly believe that learning a new language should not be the final goal for children, but rather the beginning of discovering and gaining new experiences.

Because Antonio is committed to creating a brighter future for as many young people as he can, he has shared PRIMOK's curriculum and expertise with multiple other programs, including CSK, bringing the opportunities that education provides to other corners of Cañar and Azuay.
