**Nourishing 1,000 Lives Every Month** 

The Cuenca Foundation distributes supplemental food kits to support approximately 1,000 people including families, the elderly, and individuals facing food insecurity. While staples like rice, beans, and eggs form the foundation of each kit, we know that fresh produce is essential to real nourishment.

That's why we go beyond the basics. Our kits always include vegetables selected for their nutritional value, availability, cost, and resilience. We regularly include potatoes, plantains, onions, and carrots—ingredients that are hearty and easy to store, cook, and enjoy.

The magic touch, though, comes from Diana, our "veggie lady." A dedicated community partner, Diana donates delicate, high-nutrient vegetables like kale, cilantro, and chard. These special items make a difference and are a welcome addition to what TCF provides. As Diana puts it, "This is my contribution. I'm part of the team."

All the produce is cultivated by a San Joaquín women's farming cooperative, ensuring that our food kits support local agriculture and female-led livelihoods. With your continued support, we're not just feeding people—we're nourishing minds, bodies, and futures.

What made this session truly special was the presence of a father who attended in support of his daughter. With his wife undergoing cancer treatment and unable to attend, he stepped in to ensure his daughter had the support she needed.
