
New Smiles for a Brighter Future Official Launch of Children's Dental Program

On October 16, The Cuenca Foundation officially launched a new dental program for children from underprivileged families, in partnership with the Dr. Grace Ordoñez Dental Group.

Sonia and Karen, daughters of Maria, were the first to receive care. Maria is a single mother of four, including two children with disabilities. Despite many challenges, Maria is deeply committed to her children's health and education. In the past, she relied on emergency care at the public hospital for dental issues due to lack of access to a regular dentist.

This afternoon marked a turning point. Dra. Grace provided the girls with thorough examinations and created personalized treatment plans, which she will be offering completely free of charge.
